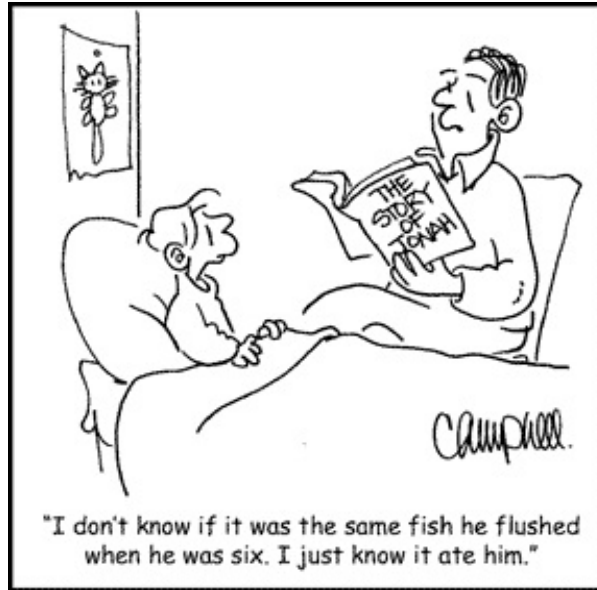

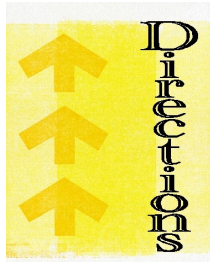

**Children's Camp June 25-29, 2012**

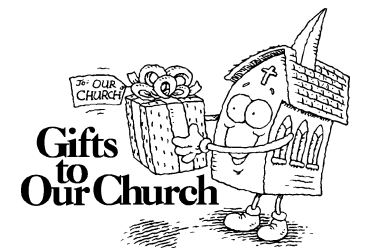
